

Title: General Certificates of Validation**Summary:**

The Bermuda Department of Civil Aviation currently issues block Certificates of Validation to predominantly Airlines operating Bermuda registered aircraft under an I.C.A.O. Article 83*bis* transfer agreement. These block validations take the form of a comprehensive list of pilot names and licence numbers duly confirmed by the Chief Pilot of the Airline.

Detail:

As the result of a recent I.C.A.O. audit of the Bermuda Department of Civil Aviation, it will now be necessary for all submitted lists of pilots for validation be verified. This means that the names and licence details must be verified as accurate and correct by the Aviation Authority that issued the licences.

This can be accomplished by having the National Aviation Authority issue the list under their own title, or alternatively to have the list scrutinized and certified as being correct by the Authority. In each case all individual pages will require to be verified as correct.
