AIR NAVIGATION (OVERSEAS TERRITORIES) ORDER 2007

GENERAL EXEMPTION No. BDA / PAVE / 224 (Re-issue) – AREA NAVIGATION AND REQUIRED NAVIGATION PERFORMANCE

1. The Director of Civil Aviation, in exercise of the powers of the Governor of Bermuda under Article 146 of the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order 2007, as amended, (the Order) hereby exempts, subject to the conditions set out in paragraph 2 below, any aircraft registered in Bermuda, together with the operator and commander thereof, from the requirements of Article 53(2) of the Order to the extent necessary to enable the aircraft to be operated in airspace designated for Basic Area Navigation (BRNAV) or Required Navigation Performance 5 (RNP-5) operations.
2. This exemption is granted subject to the following conditions:
 - (a) no flight shall be made pursuant to this exemption unless the approved flight manual in respect of the aircraft permits operation in such designated airspace; and
 - (b) the operator of the aircraft shall have established and implemented prior to such flight appropriate procedures for use by the flight crew of the aircraft in the event of any failure or degradation of the equipment required by Article 53(1) of the Order.
3. This exemption shall have effect from the date hereof and shall remain in effect until 13 August 2013 unless previously suspended, varied or revoked.
